Helps

- I. What is Repentance?
 - a. **Goal:** To understand what repentance is.
 - b. **Lesson:** Learn what repentance means at the appropriate age group.
 - c. **Examples:**
 - i. Repent means to change your mind about something, or turn away.
 - ii. Repenting of sin is turning away from sin and turning to God.
2. Was there a time in your life that you realized you were going the wrong way, stopped, and turned around?
 - a. **Goal:** To understand that we often will find ourselves on a path that is not where we should be.
 - b. **Lesson:** Learn how to identify if you are on the wrong path and how to adjust your course.
 - c. **Examples**
 - i. Talk about what happened.
 - ii. When did they recognize that they did something wrong?
 - iii. How did they feel after?
3. What are some examples of times when repentance can be important?
 - a. **Goal:** To understand that repentance is a fundamental aspect of Christian living.
 - b. **Lesson:** Learn about times we should be repentant.
 - c. **Examples:**
 - i. When a lie was told.
 - ii. You took something without asking for permission.
 - iii. You hurt someone's feelings.
 - iv. Neglecting your chores or responsibilities.
 - v. Swearing.
4. What does it take to repent?
 - a. **Goal:** To understand that repenting is a process.
 - b. **Lesson:** Learn some simple ways of repenting for your age group.
 - c. **Examples:**
 - i. Recognize the sin.
 - ii. Feeling sorrow for the sin.
 - iii. Confessing the sin to God.
 - iv. Forsake (Abandon) the sin.
5. What are examples from history of men that have repented changing their actions and attitude?
 - a. **Goal:** To understand that others have been through many challenges much like we will.
 - b. **Lesson:** Learn what they did and how they repented.

c. **Examples:**

- i. David: 2 Samuel 24:10
- ii. Ahab: I Kings 21:27-29
- iii. Prodigal Son: Luke 15

Scripture Ideas

Luke 5:32

- Fox – God wants us all to be sorry for doing wrong.
- Hawk – We are all sinners and when we sin we should repent.
- Mt Lion – Jesus paid our price for sin and we still must repent and abandon any further sin.
